



Dear Parents and Ladies of the Class of Two Thousand Twenty Nine,

The Houston Girls Cotillion was established in the late 1960's making it the first modern Cotillion in Houston for high school young ladies. It enjoys a long history of providing a dinner and dance for sophomore and junior girls attending both private and public schools in Houston. Often times, Cotillion events are the student's first experience in a formal dance setting. Since 2005, the H.G.C. moved from selective membership to limiting membership to only young ladies attending Duchesne Academy, Second Baptist School, and Memorial High School during their sophomore and junior years.

Each year, membership is offered to two different Cotillion classes for those young ladies attending the network of schools; one for sophomore and a second for juniors wishing to rejoin or join for the first time. It continues as a formal dance hosted by The Houston Girls Cotillion Board.

We would like to invite your junior daughter to join the 59th Houston Girls Cotillion ("HGC"), class of 2029.

Houston Girls Cotillion is an independent social club with no school affiliation. Eligibility of membership is defined by the schools attended but has no affiliation with a school or school district. This Social Club is completely independent and is governed by a Cotillion Board made up of mothers volunteering their time and talents.

The date of registration is Wednesday, September 23, 2026. Please make note of all the details surrounding registration:

- The registration information and related forms are available on-line at Houston Girls Cotillion Website: www.HoustonGirlsCotillion.com. Please be sure to access the Class of 2029 tab on the website when registering.
- The Rules and Regulations of H.G.C. should be reviewed, retained and agreed upon prior to your completion of your Cotillion Class of 2029 Sophomore Registration form. Completion of this form and payment confirms you accept the Rules and Regulations in its entirety.
- The Cotillion dues for the junior year are \$395.00 for those who register by September 23, 2026.
- Late registration dues are \$415.00 beginning September 26, 2026.
- All registration will be closed September 30, 2026 or sooner if we reach capacity before this date.
- * No changes to the registration list after this date.
- There are no discounts after the dates listed above and there are NO REFUNDS ISSUED.
- Cancellation Policy is as follows: If the Cotillion Dinner and Dance does not take place (for any reason), the Board will take all dollars available in the account and divide it by the number of members. Every member will receive a refund of any dollars remaining. We are a volunteer organization and the membership funds are used to place deposits on all items related to the night of the event. To the extent deposits are returned from vendors, we will do our very best to return as much as possible to each member of Cotillion. Refunds will be issued only if the Cotillion Dinner and Dance is cancelled. Refunds will not be in full. Refunds will equal only the amount of available funds.

Class of 2029

The Registration Form along with payment should be completed on Wednesday, September 23, 2026 to ensure your daughter's membership. Traditionally, The Cotillion has had a waiting list, so please register early. We will have to cut off registration once we reach our capacity. The Cotillion membership is accepted on a first come, first reserve basis. The date of your registration will be numbered in the order payment is received.

The Sophomore Cotillion will be held Saturday, the 16th of January 2027. This is a FORMAL event. Young ladies are expected to wear long gowns and young gentlemen are to wear tuxedo attire.

How to Register?

- Go to HoustonGirlsCotillion.com click on the tab for the Class of 2029. This will open on Wednesday, September 23, 2026, at 9am and will be the time/date stamp on applications.
- Complete the online Registration Form and submit it electronically. All forms must be submitted online.
- There are 3 acceptable forms of payment: (1) electronically via Zelle (preferred), (2) check or (3) cash delivered to the drop off location listed below.
 - o For payment sent by Zelle, please submit to houstoncotillion2029treasurer@gmail.com and in the optional Memo line, include your daughter's first and last name and school. There is a QR code at the bottom of this page for Zelle.
 - o For check/cash please deliver, BY SEPTEMBER 25th to guarantee membership, to Christie Ross, 611 Shartle, Houston, TX 77024. **Make sure to include your daughter's name and school on the envelope with cash, and note her name and school on the memo line of the check.**
 - o Please note that the application is time/date stamped from the online registration process. The payment must be received by September 25th to confirm membership.

What Comes Next? Members will receive an email confirming membership once the Registration Form and payment is received. You will receive additional information throughout the process by email correspondence.
